



The Covenant of Protection

The token was a scarlet rope that she had used to let them down from her roof. Surely, the Blood of Jesus that the scarlet cord and the blood of an animal symbolized is infinitely greater than any of these symbols. Today every time we participate in the Lord's Supper or the Communion Table, we are testifying that we have faith that the Blood of Jesus not only saves us from our sins but also protects us. By faith, we apply His blood to our person and our property and we bind demonic spirits released to cause accidents, violence, disasters and sudden death.
